FROM THE MANAGER'S DESK

Many thanks to Jean Buehler for being the party coordinator for the luau. She did a fantastic job as "MC" and everyone had a great time.

The speed limit on the inner streets of the Park is 10 miles per hour, with a maximum speed of 15 miles per hour being acceptable. Many residents walk, ride bikes, scooters, and golf carts and do not want to become a victim at the hands of an inconsiderate driver. 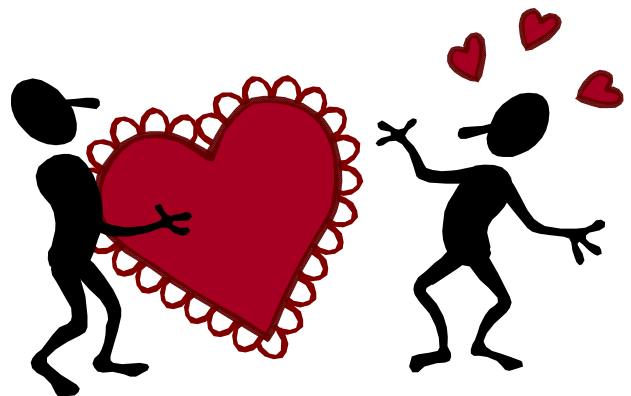

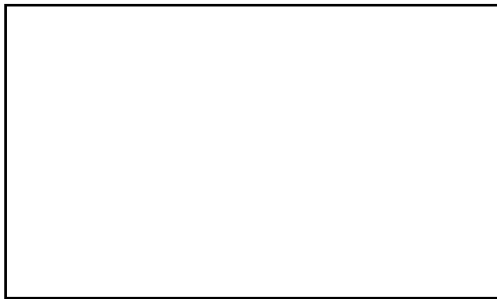

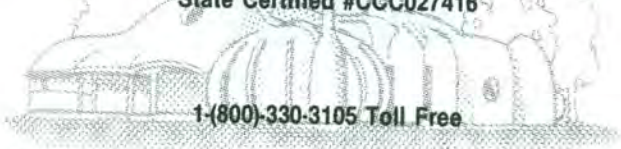
